





A National Vision and Strategy

- Availability of Data for primary care and secondary use for patients and care providers
- Trust in quality of data
- Governance helps building trust by binding agreements
- Created with "all" stakeholders in healthcare under leadership of Ministry of Health



Status of Wegiz*

- Dutch legislation stating that all data interchange in healthcare must be done digitally. Aligned with the European Health Data Space (EHDS) priorities for cross-border exchange.
- Came into effect on July 1, 2023 with a multi-year (2023-2028) adoption plan affecting:
 - Patient Summary (medical specialist referral)
 - Nursing Discharge Report
 - Medical Imaging (images and reports)
 - Medication (prescription and dispensation, medication overview, lab results for medication, adverse event monitoring)
 - Emergency Care










Information Standard or "IG"

Published and maintained by Nictiz under NEN7522 governance with all relevant health care stakeholders around one or more use cases.

Takes the Quality Standard, NEN Norm(s) and EU eHealth Network Guidelines as input and defines the Functional and Technical Design of the information exchanged for the healthcare domain under consideration.

State of lab implementation in NL

All GP results based on Edifact MEDLAB since 1989. Orders possible through intermediary. Push only.

All hospital care orders/results based on HL7 V2(.xyz) since > 199x. Mostly push, query possible.


GP and secondary care on HL7 V3/CDA since 2004 for specific use cases including exchanges in community-based care, out of hour services, patient summary, emergency care, maternal/birth care. Both push and query.

Patient access to results through GP* and limited submission [vital signs/blood sugar] since 2017 based on FHIR STU3. Access query only, submission push only

Almost all efforts of the past few years go into upgrading and replacing all reporting to ordering providers and patients with FHIR R4, so we have a single baseline








Current status of FHIR in NL

- * This list is by no means complete
- Mental Health around autism since 2015 FHIR <= DSTU1- upgraded IG to FHIR R4 in 2023
- MedMij patient facing network since 2016. Mostly STU3, some R4
 - Patient Summary, General Practitioner, Vital Signs, Medication, PDF/A document exchange
- Medication new style incl everything medication safety in R4 (hybrid with V3/CDA)
- Vaccination/immunization in R4
- **nl-core** profile/terminology set for STU3 (production) and R4 (beta)

HL7 Netherlands FHIR Council + Validation team for national vetting of third party works with representation of all stakeholders



Learnings

- Aligning timelines helps greatly
- Participate internationally, engage nationally
 - HL7 Europe is able to produce quality in a timely fashion
- Have national governance and set up rules
 - To increase scalability
- Terminology server is a key component
 - National terminology support, translation, mapping, value sets
- Qualification/certification testing is important, but generally test as much as possible
 - Continuous integration, scenarios, designathon, hackathon, connnectathon ...

HL7 National FHIR Migration Project

National Law April 2023: FHIR mandatory for healthcare information exchange in all health sectors/domains

New roles of HL7 NL:

- Technical level: knowledge sessions, migration options, NL-Core profiles, localization, validation
- Policy level : migration strategy, project approach, national architecture, adoption, \$\$\$, vendor issues

HL7 NL roles on Policy level (Ministry Health, Nictiz, vendors):

- Advice on future baseline standards (currently: zibs, FHIR STU3/R4 and Snomed)
- Participate in Expert Team: Standards selection criteria for admittance to national information architecture
- Advice on National Release Policy
- Participate in developing dedicated NEN (CEN/ISO) norms: identification, authentication, authorization, consent, source address
- Advice on National Migration Strategy: how 26+ organizations should migrate their standards to FHIR
- Participate in design of National Healthcare Information System : conceptual, technical, info & Infra structure
