



### What is the EU-a-thon?

- The EU-a-thon is an event centered on developing the European HL7 FHIR specification including resources, profiles and implementation guides.
- The purpose is to advance and prove that the specification is complete and to progress with the HL7 FHIR implementation guide maturity.



### What is the EU-a-thon?

- The EU-a-thon seeks to involve participants by facilitating informal discussions, sharing experiences, and conducting initial implementation exercises, as well as examining new adoption scenarios.
- It offers a venue for collaborative investigation.
- Insights gathered from these sessions will be crucial for the development of the specifications.



### Why the EU-a-thon?

- Minimise the time and expenses associated with highly reusable healthcare APIs while enhancing their quality.
- Enable various stakeholders to connect with one another to
  - uncover potential gaps in development or in the understanding of the specifications
  - pinpoint possible challenges in their implementations
  - Encourage discussions regarding current/developing guides
  - Foster innovative ideas



### **How it works?**

- EU-a-thon participants come together to work alongside vendors, peers, healthcare providers and administrators, as well as those that actually wrote the HL7 FHIR specification.
- Validation tools are made available for developers to rapidly learn to implement the standard and check their conformance to the specification and mature implementation guides.



### **How it works?**

- The EU-a-thon will be held over 2 days (February 11 and 12)
- It is composed of multiple *Tracks* focusing on a specific use case
  - Profile, Resource, Operation
  - Implementation Guide
  - -Workflow
- Each track has at least one coordinator Track Lead
- Participation requires some advance planning and preparation



### **How it works?**

- Activities will consist of:
  - Detailed discussions on use cases
  - Verification of implementation guides
  - Enhancement of the HL7 FHIR Specification
  - Exchange of adoption challenges, experiences, and best practices
  - Breakout working sessions



### Who should attend?

- Anyone! You don't need to be a developer...
- Domain experts, healthcare providers...
  - bring your ideas and needs and see how they could be implemented
  - Check if what is there fits for purpose
- Vendors, developers
  - Verify your implementations
  - Test the specifications

  - Check specification consistency and applicability

# Hospital Discharge Report, European Patient Summary, Common/Base Profiles

- **Goal**: engage participants in the ongoing development of a new set of HL7 FHIR Implementation Guides (IGs) under HL7 Europe.
- Brief introduction to the guides, highlighting their relationships and interconnectedness.
- Breakout sessions to facilitate the sharing of participant experiences, and practical implementation issues will be explored in depth.
- Early implementers are invited to prove their implementations.



# Hospital Discharge Report, European Patient Summary, Common/Base Profiles

### **Common Cancer Model**

 Goal: make first steps to develop the European Cancer Model, basis for the <u>HL7 Europe Cancer Common FHIR Implementation</u> <u>Guide</u>

- Brief introduction of the topic,
- Presentation, discussion, and consolidation of a preliminary high level draft of the common cancer model (Q1 and Q2)
- Identification of the attributes of some of the entities in the consolidated entity diagram.



### **Laboratory Report**

 Tue Q4 joint with Hospital Discharge Report, European Patient Summary and Common/Base Profile

#### Wed Q2

- National FHIR-based lab report, harmonization of national CDA-based lab report with EEHRxF
- Visualization with <u>vi7eti</u>, synthetic data with <u>SYNDERAI</u>
- Early implementers are invited to prove their implementations



### **Imaging Report**

- **Goal**: testing the preliminary IG (to be published) examples, taking example imaging reports and coding them in the IG format. Participants are invited to bring their own country specific examples, so we have a good coverage.
- Tue- Q2 introduction and kick-off work on examples
- **Tue- Q4** joint with Hospital Discharge Report, European Patient Summary and Common/Base Profile, lessons learned and discuss issues found work on examples
- Wed- Q3 lessons learned and discuss issues found create report out

- Experts, industry, and EU-funded projects are converging on the HL7 FHIR as a route to interoperable healthcare and a central tenet of the European Electronic Health Record and its Exchange Format.

# Policy Updates – 100 Days of the New Commission

- Artificial Intelligence Act 13 June 2024 The Al Act addresses the risks of Al. The Al Act (Regulation (EU) 2024/1689 establishes harmonised rules on artificial intelligence), provides Al developers and deployers with clear requirements and obligations regarding specific uses of Al. At the same time, the regulation seeks to reduce administrative and financial burdens for business, in particular small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs). - European Health Data Space 8 January 2025 The Council of the EU adopts new regulation improving cross-border access to EU health data. This new law will make it easier to exchange and access health data at EU level, paving the way for it to come into force. 


