No front door

A newcomer, a student, a new HL7 affiliate member — there is no low-cost, no-commitment way to walk in and see what HL7 Europe and European HL7 Affiliates are doing



A slow loop

A question raised in one country's Affiliate takes months to reach the people, the experts who can answer it — if it ever does.



A scattered signal

Europe-wide input for the role of HL7 standards in EHDS is assembled ad hoc, from scratch, every single time it is needed. The HL7 community in Europe can do better.

Six rules that keep it a Townhall

The operating principles that keep the format open, predictable and community-owned.

Open door

No membership, no fee, open to all. Recorded and published the same week.

Quarterly rhythm

Four times a year, on a Monday. The next date is announced before this one closes.

Community Events

Contribute and discuss ideas and topics for community events. It is your meeting.

Low language barrier

Topics and Questions accepted in writing beforehand in your language townhall@HL7europe.org.

The loop closes

Every session publishes the townhall news: what was raised, who owns it, what's next

Fresh voices

Spotlight community voices from across the HL7 Europe ecosystem so that all perspectives are heard

*Cost to run: one hour of chair time, one hour of secretariat time, one page of notes, bringing Europe's Health Interoperability community together: to **share** what is happening, **hear** what is needed, **connect** people and initiatives, and **shape** our common interoperability agenda.*

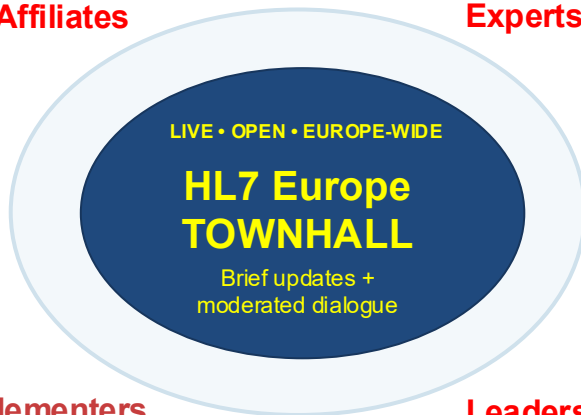

Track 2 — Community Events

Track 3: HL7 Europe Initiatives

Hospitals on FHIR Ambassador Program



- **Role** — A volunteer appointed by HOF Steering Committee to represent and animate Hospitals-on-FHIR at national level.
- **Mission** — Animate a national sub-community, connect local providers and projects, translate European goals and the Maturity Model locally, engage new members, inspire at events.
- **Where we stand** — 17 Ambassadors in 11 countries at end-2025, supporting some 130 hospital members.
- **Team & term** — 2–3 per country, mixing provider, industry and public-sector profiles; renewable two-year, activity-based terms.
- **Baseline commitment** — ~2 hours a week; monthly Board call (last Friday, 14:00 CEST); outreach every 2–3 months; one local event and the annual Maturity Model questionnaire.
- **Neutrality & recognition** — HOF endorses no vendor or product; Ambassadors gain community access, input to publications, the Ambassador identity and referral incentives

Track 4: Communications and Marketing

HL7 Europe Marketing & Communications Committee

- **Chair:** Line Andreassen, HL7 Norway
- **Purpose** — Shape and steward HL7 Europe's marketing and communications strategy: raise awareness of HL7 Europe and its affiliates, support adoption of HL7 standards across Europe, and keep brand and messaging consistent with HL7 International.
- **Remit** — Owns the annual strategic communications plan; brand, visual identity and editorial standards; channels and content calendar; event, stakeholder and member communications; performance measurement. Day-to-day delivery sits with the Communications Manager.
- **Reporting and governance** — Reports to the HL7 Europe Board; the Board-member Co-Chair presents a report at each quarterly Board meeting. No independent authority over budget or binding commitments unless delegated by the Board — it recommends, the Board approves.
- **Measurement** — Rolling strategy reviewed against agreed KPIs at every meeting: reach and engagement across channels, newsletter and membership growth, event participation, media presence, and affiliate uptake of shared assets.
- **Get involved** — Affiliates are invited to nominate a communications representative. Dedicated mailing list connects with the European HL7 affiliates community for shared assets and campaign requests.

Track 6: Education and Training

HL7 Europe Education Committee- eLearning EHDS

- **Purpose** — Governance and management body for HL7 Europe's educational activity: direction, coordination and oversight.
- **Educational plan** — Sets Europe's education strategy with HL7 International and delivers it across curriculum, WGM tutorials, instructor and material quality, affiliate outreach, eLearning and EU-project training.
- **eLearning** — Self-paced offering that delivers the European curriculum framework independently of WGM attendance; the Committee owns its currency, accessibility and reporting.
- **EHDS focus** — Advises the Board on alignment with HL7 FHIR, EEHRxF and EHDS topics, and turns project-funded training material into durable, reusable assets.
- **Design approach** — Evidence-informed and practice-rich: short input, worked examples with fading scaffolding, hands-on build and validate, routine retrieval, peer and expert feedback.
- **Governance** — Chair plus at least four Board-appointed members, including an HL7 International Education liaison, eLearning Coordinator and affiliate representatives; meets six+ times a year and at each WGM.

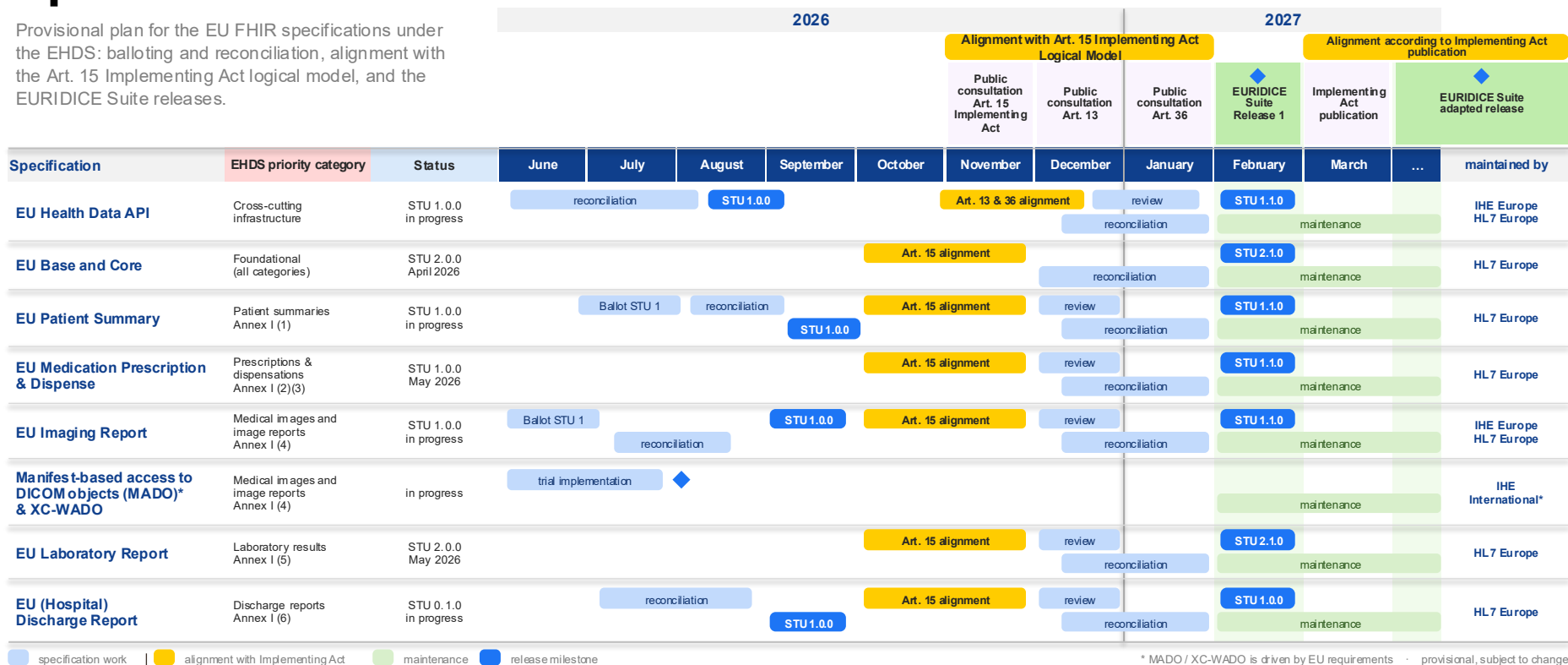
